## Over 2,000 athletes compete in 2008 State Championships

For nine days in December, Lee County and the City of Cape Coral was the Senior Athlete Capital of Florida. The Southwest Florida area will retain that title in 2009 and 2010 as a two-year extension was signed for an unprecedented five-year run (2006-10).

The 17th Annual Florida Senior Games State Championships featured over 2,000 athletes competing in 23 sports. Those athletes set 70 new age group records, continued streaks of gold-medal winning performances and qualified for the 2009 National Senior Games.

Now well into the second decade of competition, a total of 30,387 senior athletes have participated in the Games and a select few athletes have etched their names into the Florida Senior Games State Championships Record Book in three different age groups.

Another sign of the determination of the Senior Athlete is the amazing number of over 70 athletes registered for the 2008 Games.

Of the 2,052 athletes registered, a total of 828 athletes were age 70 and over. That's 40% of the registration database. Over 600 athletes in their 70s competed along with over 175 octogenarians and 14 athletes over the age of 90.

From the time the starting gun sounded at the 10K Road Race in Downtown Fort Myers early Saturday morning, December 6 until the final Billiards ball was sunk on late Sunday afternoon, December 14 in Cape Coral, over 900 gold medals were awarded.

Now it's on to the 2009 schedule of Florida Senior Games local qualifiers and the 2009 National Senior Games in the San Francisco Bay area, August 1-15.



## Naples bowler Gerald Brunette wins four medals in three days

Gerald Brunette, of Naples, came one pin short of establishing a new men's singles Bowling all-time high score, when he rolled a combined three-game score of 774. His score did set a record in the 65-69 age group, breaking the previous record by 45 pins.

Brunette rolled games of 249, 245 and 280. In 2006, Brunette rolled the only 300 game in the 17-year history of the Florida Senior Games State Championships.

Over three days of bowling, he won a gold and three silver medals. He won two silver medals in men's doubles and mixed doubles on Saturday, a gold in men's singles on Sunday and a silver medal as a member of the Intowishin team.

Four 90+ year old bowlers competed Sunday at Ten Pin Lane as the oldest athlete of the Games, 99-year old Roger Gentilhomme had a three-game score of 284.

In the men's 90-94 age group, 92-year old Joseph St. Pierre, of Seminole set a new age group record with a 490 and won the gold medal over 94-year old James Kales, of Bonita Springs, who finished with a score of 483. 94-year old Lillian Webb, of Sebring, rolled a 294 for the gold medal.

## Jacksonville's Michael Brown has record-setting day throwing Javelin

Michael Brown shattered the Florida Senior Games State Championships Javelin throw record in the 55-59 age group by 35 feet with a heave of 191 feet, three inches into a stiff win at South Fort Myers High School. Brown also holds the 50-54 age group record with a throw of 226 feet in 2004. Both throws are the longest in State Championships history.

Also at the Track & Field meet, 94-year old Lillian Webb broke her own Discus Throw record in the 90-94 age group by nearly five feet. Her throw of 30 feet, 10 inches topped her previous record of 25 feet, 11 inches set in 2006. Webb also won gold medals in the Long Jump and Shot Put.

In the running events, Julie Sands of Winter Haven broke the 50-54 age group records in the 800 and 1500 meter runs to win gold medals. Her time in the 800 meter run of 2:46.98 was 16 seconds faster than the previous record, set by Jocelyn Lowther in 2004. Her record breaking performance in the 1500 meter run was even more impressive as her time of 5:43.03 was more than 33 seconds faster than the record set by Lucia Shattelyn in 1996.

Tallahassee's Bill Tharpe recorded the fastest time of all sprinters in the 100 meter dash running a 12.79 to set a new record in 60-64 age group. His gold medal winning time of 27.32 in the 200 meter was 1/100<sup>th</sup> of a second shy of the record in his age group.

## All-time low score recorded in 17 years of Florida Senior Games State Championships golf

Robert Nichols, of Englewood, shot a five-under par 67 at The Golf Club at Magnolia Landing setting a new all-time low score in the 17-year history of the Florida Senior Games State Championships. The previous low was 68 shot on four different occasions and Nichols becomes the sixth golfer in the history of the Games to card a score under 70.

The 52-year old posted a 33 on the front nine, with a birdie on the par 3 second hole and an eagle on the par 5 ninth hole. His score of 34 on the back nine included a birdie on a par four 17<sup>th</sup> hole and a second eagle on a par 5 18<sup>th</sup> hole.

His eagle on the 485 yard ninth hole was set up by a 325 yard drive, followed by a nine-iron shot onto the green eight inches from the cup. On the 472-yard 18<sup>th</sup> hole, Nichols began with a 280 yard drive, followed by a seven-iron shot to the green. He sunk a 25-foot putt on his final shot of the day.

"I had some flashes of brilliance today," said Nichols, who played collegiate golf at Pensacola Junior College and the University of Toledo. "The birdies made up for the two bogeys when I three putted a couple of times."

Nichols carries a +2 handicap but says his claim to fame are 27 holes-in-one he has made during his golfing career. He was urged to participate in the Florida Senior Games State Championships by his father, Robert Nichols, Sr., a former Florida Senior Games athlete who competed in swimming and racquetball.

Corkey Nydle, of The Villages, shot an 84 in the Women's Golf competition to claim her sixth gold medal in the last seven years. In 2004, she won a silver medal missing the gold by three strokes. The record holder in the 70-74 and 75-79 age group, Nydle's score of 84 was seven strokes better than the silver medalist in the 75-79 age group.

Linda Frisch, of The Villages, had the lowest score of the field with an 80 to win the gold in the 60-64 age group.

### **First-time cyclist sweeps gold in all four races**



Cori Dowling, of Winter Park, had all time best rides with record-breaking times in the Cycling 5 & 10K Time Trials. Her time of 7:39.25 in the 5K Time Trials was 19 seconds faster than the previous all time best set by Joann McCranels, of Riveria Beach in 1998. Her time of 15:48.43 beat the previous 10K all-time best by 1:11. The previous record was 16:59, set by Margo Schneider, of Clearwater in 1998. Dowling, who participated in her first Florida Senior Games State Championships, was a 2007 Duathlon National Champion in her age group.

Also setting 5 & 10K records in the 80-84 age group was Phyllis Goodland, of Dade City, whose mark of 11:35.59 in the 5K broke the previous record set in 1998, by more than two minutes. Her 10K time of 24:35.83, broke Mary Peterson's record time of 26:17 from 1994.

In the men's competition, Eric Lippens, of Naples, broke his own 5K record in the 60-64 age group and set a new mark in the 60-64 age group with a time of 14:46.80, 22 seconds better than the previous record.

### **West Coast runner wins 5 & 10K Road Races in Lee County**

Did you hear the one about the guy who traveled from Olympia, Washington to Fort Myers, Florida to qualify for the National Senior Games?

That's what Craig Anderson, the winner of the 10K Road Race did on the opening day of the 2008 Florida Senior Games State Championships. Even more impressive than the miles traveled was the time the 61-year old posted, an all-time best 38:21, spanning two bridges across the Caloosahatchee River in downtown Fort Myers.

The toughest part of the task was adjusting his body clock to Eastern time. "The race time was 8AM, but my body clock was telling me it was 4AM," Anderson said after the race. He finished 20 seconds ahead of the second overall finisher, Chuck Moseley, of Naples, a recently turned 50-year old Senior Games athlete.

Anderson was a collegiate distance runner at Montana State in the 1960's and won the 10K Gold Medal at the 2005 National Senior Games in the 55-59 age group.

### **Clearwater Aces top century mark on the Basketball court**

The Clearwater Aces 60+ Basketball team recorded the highest scoring output of the Florida Senior Games State Championships in a 113-55 win over the Limestone Cowboys at the Estero Community Center. The 113 points topped the previous high from 2006 when the Phantoms, of St. Petersburg, defeated the Fossils, of Oviedo, 105-80. John Salter led the Aces with 40 points while Harry Carothers added 33. The 60+ Clearwater Aces team has now won nine gold medals in the last 10 years.

In the 50-54 age group, the Polk Players won three games to win their third consecutive gold medal. In the 66-62 championship game against Thirsty's of Houston, Texas, George Tinsley led the Players with 22 points and Rick Reass added 17.

## Shultz stands alone as 16-year Senior Games Medal Winner

By winning a gold medal in men's doubles table tennis, John Shultz, of Inverness, extended his streak of earning Florida Senior Games State Championships medals to 16 years. It is the longest consecutive years streak of any Florida Senior Games athlete.

Shultz and his partner Deane Chickering won the gold in the 70-74 age group at the Estero Community Center as 112 Table Tennis players competed in Singles, Doubles, Men's, Women's and Mixed Doubles.

Shultz's streak began in 1993 competing in the 55-59 age group. During the 16 year span, Shultz has won 11 gold medals, four silvers and one bronze.

To get to the 2008 Florida Senior Games State Championships, Shultz had to overcome the Shingles, which left the right side of his face visibly red. "It's still pretty painful," he said after competing all day in men's singles and doubles.

Long-time women's doubles partners, Jan Cline and Dorothy Hann, of Sun City Center, claimed their 11<sup>th</sup> gold medal, winning the 70-74 age group. The duo won five gold medals in 60-64 age group between 1996 and 2000, three golds from 2001 and 2003 in the 65-69 age group and have won the last three years in the 70-74 age group.

Michael Rusaw, of The Villages, won a pair of gold medals in men's singles and doubles 65-69 age group. Rusaw was undefeated in six matches to advance out of the 18-player, men's singles bracket and teamed with Kenneth Riggs, of Lady Lake, to win the men's doubles gold medal.

## It's all net at the Basketball Shooting

Three former Florida Senior Games State Championships Athletes of the Year won gold medals in Basketball Shooting Friday at the Estero Community Center and Andy McGuffin, of Umatilla (2005) and Claudette Braswell, of Lake Wales (2007) won golds in all three events. Harry Carothers, of Pinellas Park (2004), won two gold medals.

McGuffin's three gold medals raises his medal count to 35 medals won since 1994. He has won 12 Free Throw Shooting, 12 Spot Field Goal Shooting and 11 Time Field Goal shooting golds.

Three Free Throw shooters on the men's side sunk a total of 29 of 30 shots. Bob Short of Gainesville, Carothers and Donald Jeppsen of The Villages, were one shy of a perfect score to win gold medals. Short (60-64 age group) missed his seventh of 30 shots and responded with 23 consecutive made shots. Carothers (65-69 age group) connected on his first 22 consecutive shots before a miss and then hit the next seven. Jeppsen (75-79 age group) missed his eighth shot and then made 22 straight. Braswell's overall high total on the women's side, of 27, included 14 consecutive made shots to win gold in the 70-74 age group.

Peter Smith, of The Villages, had the high score of the Spot Field Goal shooting, making 14 of 15 shots. He came up short on his final shot, missing the field goal from the top of the key.

En route to 146 total points in the Timed Field Goal Shooting, Harry Carothers hit 28 shots from three point range, during three 60 second intervals, for the highest total of the Timed Field Goal shooting. Carothers gold medal, in the 65-69 age group, is his 10<sup>th</sup> consecutive in the event since 1999. The total of 146 was six points shy of his all-time best score of 152 in the 2005 Games.

## Quick Shout Outs from...

### Softball

At the women's softball, the Village Vixens 60+ team wrapped up an undefeated record for the weekend with a 5-0 win over Ken Marshall/Sun Harbor Realty. Jeannie Harrington had a double and a triple and scored two runs in the win. The Vixens scored 36 runs in three games for the gold medal.

## **Bocce**

In Men's Bocce, Freddie's Friends, of Cape Coral was undefeated in five games en route to the gold medal. They defeated the Goodfellas, of Cape Coral in their last two matches. The Freddie's Friends team is made up of Fred Capus, Larry Bennett, Dan DiLecci and Benito Germani.

The Sisterhood, of Cape Coral, consisting of team members Jay Bennett, Virginia Cordano, Dayle Bragen and Irene Capus defeated The Red Hot Bocce Belles in the Championship match to win the women's gold medal. Bennett, Bragen and Capus were members of the 2007 gold medal winning team, The Capettes.

## **Swimming**

In the second day of swimming competition, Pat Bond, of Bradenton, won three gold medals and set two records to bring her two-day total to six gold medals and four new records in the 70-74 age group. Bond, the 1999 Female Athlete of the Year, is swimming in the 70-74 age group for the first time and now holds records in three age groups.



## **Horseshoes**

Longtime Senior Games Horseshoes pitcher, Walter Chalfant, of Mulberry, repeated as the gold medalist in the 80-84 age group at the Estero Community Center. He has now won six Florida Senior Games State Championships gold medals in three different age groups dating back to 1996.

Robert Farnsworth, of Punta Gorda, won his third consecutive horseshoes gold medal in the 75-79 age group.

## **Tennis**

In the final day of Singles Tennis competition at Florida Gulf Coast University, Jeffrey Jordan, of Englewood, won two three set matches for the gold medal in the 65-69 age group. In his first match of the day, Jordan beat Eugene Bengston, of Avon Park, 6-3, 6-7, 10-8 and defeated Sanibel's William Rosenberg, 6-2, 3-6, 10-7, to claim the gold.

Dunnellon's Bernhard Burg scored a 7-6, 6-1 win over Richard James, of The Villages, to win his third consecutive gold medal in the 75-79 age group and sixth singles gold medal since 1996. Burg has also won four mixed doubles gold medals

## **Shuffleboard**

In singles Shuffleboard at the North Fort Myers Community Center, Linda Armstrong, of Lakeland, won her fourth consecutive singles gold medal by taking the 55-59 age group championship. She won the 50-54 age group from 2005-07. The Games oldest athlete, Roger Gentilhomme, of Dunedin, won his third medal of the 2008 Games by winning the 95-99 age group.

A pair of shuffleboard doubles teams won gold medals for the third consecutive year at the North Fort Myers Community Park. Linda and Henry Armstrong won the 55-59 age group and Charles and Olean Randall won in the 85-89 age group for three in a row. Linda Armstrong won a singles shuffleboard medal on Saturday

## **Race Walk**

Donna Graham, of Lowell, OH, completed a gold medal sweep of both race walk events with a time of 8:39.71 in the 1500 meter race walk, on Sunday, December 14. She won the 5K Race Walk on Saturday, December 13 with a time of 30:21.27. Following her Gold medal winning performance at Rotary Park in Cape Coral, Graham traveled north in Cape Coral to Diamonds Billards where she won a silver medal in singles Billiards on Saturday.

## **Pickleball**

In Mixed Doubles Pickleball competition, Bill Freeman and Deb Harrison, of The Villages, won their fourth consecutive gold medal. This year, the duo won gold in the 60-64 age group after winning the last three years in the 55-59 age group. Freeman and Harrison did not lose a game in four matches in their run for the gold medal and did not allow opponents to score more than four points in eight games.

## Senior Games contributes to Toni Gibbs quality of life



Over the course of 10 years working at the Florida Senior Games State Championships, the Senior Games staff has fielded a myriad of calls about a variety of things. One such call came in during our early years from Toni Gibbs (*pictured at left*), a cyclist competing in her first Senior Games.

She wanted to know how many athletes were registered in her age group. When told there were only three, she became very excited because she was guaranteed a medal.

Fast forward to 2008 and Toni is a veteran senior athlete who plans on competing in the 2009 National Senior Games Triathlon. Over the last 10 years, Toni has competed in the Florida Senior Games, run in plenty of road races, including the New York Marathon. Her personal best marathon time is 5 hours and 41 minutes.

What's most impressive about her triathlon experience is the fact that she just learned how to swim at age 53.

"I've met so many friends at Senior Games events," she said at the Cycling 5 & 10K Time Trials in Cape Coral. "This whole experience just gives you a better quality of life."

## Former Athletes of the Year return to win even more medals

Of the over 2,000 senior athletes at the 2008 Florida Senior Games State Championships, 12 athletes could claim the title of Athlete of the Year. Every year a Male and Female Athlete of the Year are chosen from the field of competitors and a dozen former Athletes of the Year returned for action in 2008. Doris Prokopi, a swimmer from Land O' Lakes, who won the award in 1994 was the longest tenured former Athlete of the Year. When she won the honor, she was competing in the 55-59 age group. She has now advanced to the 70-74 age group.

Basketball Shooting, Swimming and Track & Field each had three former Athletes of the Year competing at their venues and combined the 12 Athletes of the Year won 57 medals during the 2008 Games.



## Senior Athletes contribute to their communities Bocce enthusiasts double as artists

In the months leading up to the 2008 Florida Senior Games State Championships, Rudy Diaz and Dan Pardo did a lot more than prepare for the Bocce competition. Diaz, the Games Bocce Sport Director, and Pardo a member of the 2007 silver-medal winning Cape Coral Dolphins have been busy working on a statue honoring U.S. troops currently engaged overseas.

The statue which has been completed and is awaiting bronze casting, is of an American soldier saluting a flag with a small boy offering a salute of his own. The boy is holding a soccer ball under his arm. "The boy was playing soccer and followed his hero to the flag," said Pardo. "That's the idea."

Following Florida Senior Games State Championships Bocce competition on Saturday, December 6, Diaz and Pardo were at the annual Cape Coral Christmas Celebration displaying their statue and seeking donations for the \$35-40,000 bronze casting process. The goal is for the statues to be in place at Four Mile Cove Ecological Preserve, in Cape Coral, by Memorial Day 2009. Pardo and Diaz previously collaborated on a panther sculpture currently displayed at the Cape Coral City Hall.



## Golden Girls and Sunrise Table Tennis Club prepare for the future of their sport

The Sunrise Table Tennis Club does more in the Tampa Bay area than play competitive table tennis. The club and the Golden Girls reinforce their sport by bringing it to area youth in conjunction with the City of Clearwater, The Nicholas Financial Resources Group and the Myrtle Wilkins Family to provide free training in table tennis to juniors, ages 10 to 17 through our after-school Junior Development and Summer Camp Programs. The programs offer free individual coaching to promising young people that show an interest in practicing and competing. The After-School Junior and Summer Camp Programs culminate with the Annual Summer Camp Table Tennis Championship.

The Sunrise Table Tennis Club also awards scholarship money each year to promising Table Tennis athletes. Applicants must also show some level of achievement in the sport along with dedication to continuing the pursuit of excellence both in table tennis and education. The use of the scholarships will be toward studies at a two- or four-year college. The scholarship was established by the family of Myrtle Wilkins, who founded the STTC in 1989. She had a great enthusiasm for the sport, and achieved fame as the National Senior Champion in her age class at the age of 75.

## Grandparent/Grandchild Relay brings Track & Field competition to a close

For the fourth consecutive year, the Senior Games Track & Field meet has come to a close with the Grandparent/Grandchild Relay race. This year, five grandparents and grandchildren ran the 2 X 100 yard relay with plenty of encouragement from the bleachers.
