Day by Day at the 2009 Florida Senior Games State Championships

Saturday, December 5

10K Road Race - Saturday, December 5

Perry Small of Cape Coral won the first gold medal of the 2009 Florida Senior Games State Championships crossing the finish line of the 10K Road Race with a time of 35:52.32 to win the 50-54 age group. Small (*pictured at right*) turned 50 the previous day to reach the minimum age requirement for the Games.

The Florida Senior Games State Championships 10K Road Race was held in conjunction with the Fort Myers Track Club Annual River Run in a steady rain Saturday morning. Small was the third overall finisher among the runners with record setting time in the 50-54 age group and the all-time Florida Senior Games State Championships fastest time. He bested the time of Craig Anderson, of Olympia, Washington, who ran the 10K race in 39:23.21 in 2008.

Archery - Saturday, December 5

Longtime Florida Senior Games State Championships Archery Sport Director provided the following report from the 2009 Archery competition.

"The weather was absolutely awful... We practiced in a drizzle, waited for the ensuing rain to abate... finally started scoring in light rain... for approximately 1/3 of the competition... then shot the last 2/3 of the competition in fairly strong cross wind. Very difficult shooting conditions and 27 shooters chose to NOT compete in the weather. Some didn't show, but many practiced and then "folded their tents" and decided not to compete. Those 46 who shot included three who shot from one to 12 arrows and stopped. The 43 who shot the whole tournament all seemed (and most voiced) that they had a good time."

The day began with Michelle Stahl and Shawn Hughes (2 adult archers from Lee County Archers) were presented with their "Shooter of the Year" awards earned through the year for their competitive excellence as top scoring male and female archers in the nine Florida Archery Association State Championship Tournaments.

The competition featured only one record broken in the inclement weather. Bob Wartenberg, of Plantation, set a new mark in the Male Barebow Recurve, 75-79 age group with a score of 576, advancing the record by over 100 points.

Swimming

Saturday, December 5 and Sunday, December 6

Swimmers braved the elements of rain and cold on December 5-6 at the Florida Gulf Coast University Aquatic Center. The elements didn't keep Tom Bliss and Patrice Hirr from turning in multiple record-breaking performances.

Hirr, (*pictured below*) of The Villages, won three gold medals and set records in the 60-64 age group, on Saturday, in the 50 yard backstroke with a time of 41.20, the 100 yard butterfly with a time of 1:24.27 and the

100 yard individual medley with a time of 1:25.79. Her time in the 100 butterfly was 15 seconds faster than the previous record.

She completed her six for six sweep of swimming gold medals and record breaking performances on Sunday. Her time of 35.83 in the 50-yard butterfly was the fastest overall time of all age groups. She also set records in the 100-yard backstroke and 100-yard freestyle.

Since total knee replacement surgery on her left knee on July 28, Hirr limited herself to only 50 and 100-yard races in the 2009 Games. She now holds nine age group records, having set three in the 55-59 age group in 2006. A swimmer in college at Central Michigan University and a swimmer in Master's events since her 30's, Hirr has spent most of her life involved in aquatics. She was a high school swimming coach in Grand Blanc, Michigan and the Aquatics Director at the Genesis Athletic Club in Grand Blanc, a 220,000 square foot facility that is the largest in the country.

"Swimming has been my form of exercise, my vocation and my passion in life," she said.

Tom Bliss, of Merritt Island, started the weekend with three gold medals and a new record in the 200 yard freestyle with a time of 2:01.14 and the 100 yard butterfly with a time of 59.78. With the 200 yard freestyle record, he now holds records in the 50-54 and 55-59 age group. His record-setting time of 59.78 in the 100 yard butterfly is the Games all-time best performance in the event.

He brought his total up to six gold medals in six events on Sunday and set three records in the 55-59 age group. His record breaking performances came in the 100 Yard Backstroke, 200 Yard IM and the 200 Yard Backstroke. Since 2004, Bliss has won gold medals in 34 of 36 events he has competed.

Most Decorated Swimming Gold Medalist of the Decade adds to her total

Heading into the 2009 Games, Patricia Bond, of Bradenton, was recognized for her decade-long medal winning performances between 2000 and 2008 with 49 swimming gold medals in nine years. She upped her total to 55 with six gold medals in 2009. Bond, who holds swimming age group records in three age groups (60-64, 65-69 and 70-74) won six gold medals in two days of competition. She won the 50 Yard Freestyle, 100 Yard Backstroke, 50 Yard Butterfly, 200 Yard IM, 100 Yard Freestyle and 200 Yard Backstroke.

Bowling

Saturday, December 5 and Sunday, December 6

85 and up make quite a showing

Bowling always draws some of the highest participation totals in all age groups but in the past few years, the talent level has shown to continue well into the age groups. In men's singles, 22 bowlers, age 80 and over competed. The two oldest bowlers, at 95 and 100, set records in their age groups.

Women's singles saw a 12-year old record, in the 85-89 age group, shattered by Bertha Black, of Lake City. Her three-game score of 485 would have won a gold medal in an age group 10-years younger. The same goes for Jack Appel's three game total of 568 in the 85-89 age group. It would have won a gold medal in the 75-79 age group. Appel saved his best game for last, rolling a 226 in the third game. *Appel, right in photo, pictured with Roger Gentilhomme*.

Joseph St Pierre, of Pinellas Park, who set a record in the 90-94 age group in 2008 with a score of 490, came only four pins short of his record breaking score in 2009 with a three game total of 486. All three of St. Pierre's scores were over 160. Then there was 95 year old James Kales, of Bonita Springs, rolling a three-game total of 401 to establish a record for that age group.



The Bowling competition also saw its first 100-year old as Roger Gentlihomme, of Dunedin, was better late than never in rolling a three-game total of 186. His first game total picked up well into the game as he ran a bit late to Galaxy Lanes.

Bocce Saturday, December 5 and Sunday, December 6



Dayle Bragan seems to be the essential part of a gold medal winning team in Florida Senior Games State Championships women's bocce. She is the only women's bocce player to be on the gold medal winning team in the three years bocce has been played at the Games. In 2007, she played for The Capettes, she won a gold medal with The Sisterhood in 2008 and was a member of the 2009 gold-medal winning Golden Girls. The Golden Girls of Cape Coral won four matches and defeated Team Quattro in the championship to win the 2009 Gold Medal.

At Veteran's Park in Cape Coral, the GoodFellas, of Cape Coral, won five matches to win the Men's Bocce Gold Medal defeating NWIC in the last two games of their five-game run. Besides winning a gold medal with the GoodFellas, Anthony Ceresoli, took home the Most Bocces Award.

Pickleball

Saturday, December 5 and Sunday, December 6

The Most Decorated Pickleball Gold Medal Winner of the Decade continued her winning ways as Deb Harrison, of The Villages, raised her gold medal total to 15 since 2004. Harrison won in the 60—64 age group in singles, women's doubles with partner, Jean Kiker, and in mixed doubles with partner Bill Freeman.

Harrison breezed through the women's singles bracket winning three matches and allowing her opponents to score only three points in the three games. She won her fifth women's doubles gold medal and now has gold medals in three different age groups of women's doubles competition. In mixed doubles, she won her fifth consecutive gold medal with partner Bill Freeman and sixth mixed doubles gold overall since 2004.

Pickleball sibling partners also won medals in 2009 as twin brothers, James and William Berrier won their second consecutive gold medal in Men's Doubles, 70-74 age group. The brother and sister combo of Nikki Davidge and John Rupert, of Summerfield won a mixed doubles bronze medal in the 50-54 age group. Rupert also won a gold medal in men's singles, 50-54 age group.

Volleyball


Saturday, December 5 and Sunday, December 6

In Men's Volleyball, all three gold medal winning teams did not lose a game en route to their championships. The Ref Shop won the 50+ age group while the Clearwater Aces teams won the 60+ and 65+ age group. The 65+ Clearwater Aces team won their sixth consecutive gold medal in the 65+ age group dating back to 2004.

In the first year of Beach Volleyball competition at the Florida Senior Games State Championships, Southern Masters teammates in the Men's 60+ age group, Howard Stillwell, of Navarre and Fred Schweitzer, of Apopka, won a pair of gold medals in men's team and beach volleyball competition.

Table Tennis Monday, December 7

On the day when Table Tennis took center stage at the Florida Senior Games State Championships, John Shultz, of Inverness, won a Table Tennis medal for the 17th consecutive year dating back to 1993. Shultz, who won a gold medal in Men's Singles and a silver in Men's Doubles in the 70-74 age group, holds the longest consecutive year medal winning streak in the 18-year history of the Games.



Al Palumbo, of Clearwater, and Danuta Andrzejewska, of Fort Lauderdale, completed gold medal sweeps of all three events winning gold medals in singles, doubles and mixed doubles.

Palumbo won gold medals in the 75-79 age group of Men's Singles, Men's Doubles (with partner John Campbell of Cape Coral) and Mixed Doubles (with partner Margo Lindsay).

Andrzejewska won her third 65-69 age group singles medal in four years, the women's doubles gold with partner Suzanna Sanders, of Pembroke Pines, and mixed doubles with partner Robert Gingras, of Pembroke Pines.

Tennis

Tuesday, December 8 – Sunday, December 13

The Florida Gulf Coast Tennis Courts featured the two oldest athletes of the Florida Senior Games State Championships Tuesday in singles competition as 195 years combined played a 75-minute match.

100-year old Roger Gentilhomme, of Dunedin and 95-year old James Kales, of Bonita Springs, each earned gold medals since they were the only athletes in their age group. Kales won the match 6-2, 5-3 before Gentilhomme retired in the second set.



"I started feeling like I was stumbling and was got dizzy," said Gentilhomme (*pictured at left*) after playing for more than an hour in the mid-afternoon with temperatures near or above 80. "It was a sure sign that something was happening."

After sitting down with cold towels over his head for 10 minutes or so, he got up and told his collection of friends who had gathered to encourage him, "I'm sorry I didn't live up to your expectations." He was assured they were not disappointed.

Gentilhomme recalled having to retire due to heat only one other time, "a match 25 years ago in

Sarasota."

The two had played one another before in National Senior Games competitions but not in the Florida Senior Games State Championships. Both were in singles bowling on Sunday and each set records in their respective age groups. Both men still have one more sport left on their calendars as Gentilhomme will compete in Shuffleboard on Saturday and Kales will be in Track and Field events this weekend.

In Men's Singles Tennis, Michael Thaler, of Briny Breezes took the gold medal in the 55-59 age group. It was his second medal of the Games after winning a silver medal in Men's Singles Pickleball on Sunday. Earl Bannister, of North Fort Myers, won his second consecutive gold medal in the 90-94 age group with a win over Irving Converse on Wednesday.

In Men's Doubles Tennis, Jeff Jordan, of Englewood and William Gibbs, of North Port won their fourth consecutive gold medal and fifth overall since 2002. They defeated the team of Carlton Dean & Juno Guevara, of The Villages, in straight sets by scores of 6-3, 7-6, in the 65-69 age group.

In Women's Doubles, the duo of Joanne Collier, Mulberry & Carol Newgent, Kissimmee, won their second consecutive gold medal in the 60-64 age group defeating Lynda Fulcher & Sandy Hollinger, of Sebring, 7-5, 6-4, in the championship match.

Cycling 5 and 10K Time Trials, Tuesday, December 8 / 20 and 40K Road Race, Thursday, December 10

Leesburg's Dave Viney and Cynthia La Roe, of Eustis (*pictured at right*), raced to overall fastest times in the Florida Senior Games State Championships Cycling Time Trials Tuesday in Cape Coral.

Viney, who turned 59 on the day of the Time Trialsy, finished the 10K Time Trials with a time of 13:13.518, 44 seconds faster than the previous Games best, set by Richard Aho, of Fort Lauderdale in 1998. In 13 races from February to September, 2009 listed on Viney's USA Cycling results page, he won first place in 12. Viney also rode in the 5K Time Trials and did not finish due to a flat tire at the halfway point of the race.



La Roe bested the 5K Time Trials fastest time on record by less than a second and topped the 10K fasted time by two seconds. Cynthia and her husband, Ken, competing in their first Florida Senior Games State Championships, won the 5 and 10K Gold medals in the 50-54 age group.

George Olson, of St. Augustine, broke the final record of the Time Trials, riding the 5K in 07:52.869 in the 70-74 age group.

Dave Viney, of Leesburg, and Cynthia La Roe, of Eustis, continued their gold medal winning ways in Florida Senior Games State Championships Cycling as the top male and female finishers in both the 20 and 40K Road Races in Cape Coral on Thursday.

Viney (*pictured at left*) completed the 20K Road Race with a time of 30:31.202 finishing less than one second ahead of Lee Hogan, of Inverness, to win the gold medal in the 55-59 age group. He was the first rider to cross the finish line in the 40K Road Race with a time of 1:05:01.927, again, less than a second ahead of John Tanner, of Clearwater, who the gold medal in both races in the 50-54 age group.

With first place finishes in both races on Thursday, Cynthia La Roe, of Eustis won four Cycling gold medals in the 50-54 age group. She was one of only two riders to accomplish the feat. Donald Werling, of Port Charlotte, won four gold medals in the 75-79 age group.

The 40K Race was a mad dash to the finish line as eight riders crossed the line within three seconds of one another.

"It was a conservative pace until the last two miles," said Viney after the 20K Race (12+ miles). "The cross wind coming down the final stretch made for some interesting riding. Winds like that tend to make the pack go back and forth and have the potential to cause some damage."

Golf

Men – Tuesday, December 8

Larry Rule, of Lakeland, shot the field low at the Men's Golf competition at The Golf Club at Magnolia Landing with a 75 to win the 65-69 age group. It was Rule's fourth medal in Florida Senior Games State Championships play since 2005. He won gold medals in 2005 and 2006 and won a silver in 2007.

Setting a new record in the 85-89 age group was Harry Duccilli Jr, of Amelia Island. Duccilli's 82 beat the previous low, of Lloyd McKenzie, of Lakeland, by three strokes.

Horseshoes Wednesday, December 9

In Horseshoes, held at the Estero Community Center, Walter Chalfant, of Mulberry, won the 80-84 age group gold medal to bring home his seventh gold since 1996. He won his first gold medal in the 70-74 age group in 1996 when the Games were in Kissimmee/St. Cloud.

Also winning gold was the 2007 Female Athlete of the Year Claudette Braswell, who was in her first competition of the Games. She went on to win gold medals in Basketball Shooting and Racquetball.

Golf

Women – Thursday, December 10

By shooting an 85 in Florida Senior Games State Championships Women's Golf competition Wednesday at The Golf Club at Magnolia Landing in North Fort Myers, Corkey Nydle, of The Villages, established a new record in the 80-84 age group. It is her third age group record since setting the 70-74 record in 2003. She added the 75-79 age group record in 2007.

She won the gold medal in the 80-84 age group and her score of 85 was the fourth lowest of the field of 34 on Wednesday. Nydle (*pictured at right*) has now won a gold medal in seven of the last eight years.

Janet Brown, of Lakeland, had the lowest score of the field with a 79 to win the gold medal in the 55-59 age group. It was the seventh consecutive gold medal for Brown since 2003 and she had the all-time low women's score in 2004 with a 72.



On a very windy day in Lee County, Nydle was only able to manage one birdie and five pars. Brown had one birdie and 10 pars. Since 2000, both Brown and Nydle have each won seven women's golf gold medals making them the Florida Senior Games State Championships "Most Decorated Golf Gold Medalists of the Decade."

Basketball Shooting Friday, December 11

The two best Basketball Shooters in Florida Senior Games State Championships history took the court Friday and continued their tradition of gold medal winning performances.

Andy McGuffin, of Umatilla, raised his Basketball Shooting gold medal count to 38 since 1994 by with sweep of the Free Throw Shooting, Spot Field Goal Shooting and Time Field Goal Shooting events in the 85-89 age group. Harry Carothers, of Pinellas Park, won his 11 consecutive Timed Field Goal Shooting gold medal dating back to 1999.

McGuffin, the 2005 Florida Senior Games State Championships Male Athlete of the Year, won his 13th Free Throw Shooting and Spot Field Goal Shooting gold medals and his 12th Timed Field Goal Shooting medal.

Carothers, the 2003 Florida Senior Games State Championships Male Athlete of the Year, posted the overall high score in the Timed Field Goal Shooting with 121 points, hitting 24 shots from the three point line. He has compiled the most overall points of the Timed Shooting for the last five years and his averages 129 points over that time. He had an all-time high 152 points in 2005.

Claudette Braswell, of Lake Wales, had the highest women's scores in all three events hitting 25 of 30 free throws, scoring 11 of a possible 15 points in the Spot Field Goal Shooting and scored 93 points in the Timed Field Goal Shooting. Braswell was named the 2007 Florida Senior Games State Championships Female Athlete of the Year.

Archie Grant, of Fort Myers, and Ronald Becton, of Lakeland each hit 29 of 30 free throws for the top scores of the Free Throw Shooting competition. Becton, shooting in the 50-54 age group, missed his third shot of the first round and then hit 27 consecutive free throws and the gold medal in the 70-74 age group. He missed his seventh free throw of the first round of 10 shots and then connected on the next 23 in a row.

Charles Ripstra, of Lake Wales, and Glenn Boetcher, of Lakeland, had gold medal sweeps of all three events with Ripstra winning in the 55-59 age group and Boetcher in the 75-79 age group.

3-on-3 Basketball Saturday, December 12

Two players won medals on successive days on the basketball court at the Estero Community Center as Jay Welchel, of Bradenton, and Charles Ripstra, of Lakeland took home Basketball Shooting and 3-on-3 Basketball medals. Whelchel won two gold medals and a silver in the Basketball Shooting competition and returned the following day to win a gold with the 70+ St. Augustine team. He was the leading scorer in three of St. Augustine's four games en route to the gold medal.

Ripstra won three gold medals in Basketball Shooting to bring his total overall total to 13 since 2003 and won a silver medal playing for the Lake Wales Old Timers. He led the Old Timers with 18 points in a 48-42 win over Way Below the Rim, hitting five three pointers.

Road Race

5K – Saturday, December 12

Skip Mullaney, of Fort Myers, won the first gold medal of Saturday's competition crossing the finish line as the first overall finisher of the 5K Road Race in 21:30.02, to win the gold medal in the 70-74 age group. The top women's finisher was Tweety Wolf, of Mound, MN, with a time of 21:54.81. She was the third overall finisher of the field and won the gold medal in the 50-54 age group.

Notes from the 5K Road Race.....

Top overall 5K women's finisher Tweety Wolf, was a member of the Iowa State Track and Field team where she earned All-America status in 1975 and 1977 in the One and Two-Mile Relay. She was coached by Chris Murray, the Florida Senior Games State Championships 1500 meter Race Walk Sport Director. Murray's teams at Iowa State won four AIAW Cross Country and Big Eight Championships between 1974-78. The 51-year old Wolf, of Mound, Minnesota, won the 50-54 age group with a time of 21:54.81 lives part time in Cape Coral and plans on competing in upcoming Florida Senior Games events.

The two oldest female 5K runners of the Road Race won gold medals for the third consecutive year as Marilyn Walters, of Jensen Beach, and Doreen Johnstone, of Fort Myers, each crossed the finish line at Rotary Park. Walters won a gold medal for the fifth consecutive year and won a bronze medal at the National Senior Games in August, 2009.

Track and Field

Saturday, December 12 and Sunday, December 13

Competing in his first Florida Senior Games State Championships, Brian Hankerson, of Hollywood, leaped to all-best performances in the High Jump, Long Jump and Triple Jump Saturday at South Fort Myers High School.



In Hankerson's first event of the day, his Long Jump of 19 feet, 1 ½ inches broke the previous all time best of 17 feet, 7 inches, set by Ted Kalaidi, of Jupiter in 2004, by more than a foot. He then moved to the high jump where he broke the previous best with a leap of 5 feet, 6 inches. The previous record holder, Dan Pierce watched as his record, of 5 feet, 5 inches set in 2003 was topped. Piece won a gold medal in the 55-59 age group.

He rounded out his record breaking day with a Triple Jump of 37 feet, 9 inches, besting the previous record of 36 feet, 1 inch, set by Tampa's Bobby Terrell in 2006. His efforts won gold medals in the 50-54 age group.

More record breaking performances were reached in the throwing events as James Oglesby, of Kissimmee, set three new marks in the 75-79 age group. Each of his record breaking throws in the Shot Put (42 feet, 11 inches), Discus (115 feet, 9 inches) and Javelin (99 feet) beat the previous records by eight feet or more. Oglesby also holds set 70-74 age group Shot Put record in 2007.

All totaled 22 new records were set in the Field events of the Track and Field competition. The two oldest competitors of the day, 90-year old John Anoka, of Maitland, and 95- year old James Kales, of Bonita Springs, either established records or broke records in their age groups in each event they participated on Saturday. Anoka, who has been a Florida Senior Games State Championships athlete since 1994, set two records in the 90-94 age group and Kales set five records in the 95-99 age group.

With a strong wind blowing at South Fort Myers High School, only four Track and Field age group records were broken on the final day of the Florida Senior Games State Championships.

It was only fitting that the records were broken by Florida Senior Games veterans, John Anoka, of Maitland in the 90-94 age group, Ethel Lehmann, of Largo in the 80-84 age group and June Marie Provost, of Naples in the 75-79 age group.

Anoka set a new mark in the 400 meter dash with a time of 1:58.33 and now holds the 400 meter dash record in four age groups. He set the 75-79 mark in 1995, the 80-84 record in 1999 and the 84-89 record in 2004. During Saturday's field events, he set new records in the long jump and shot put.

Lehmann ran the 100 meter dash in 20.37 and broke the previous record set in 1997 by nine seconds. Her record-breaking run in the 200 meter dash of 43.24 broke the previous mark by more than a minute. Lehmann, the 1997 Florida Senior Games State Championships Female Athlete of the Year, holds the 200 meter dash records in the 70-74, 75-79 and 80-84 age groups. She set new marks in the long jump and javelin throw on Saturday for a weekend total of four new records.

Notes from the Track...

Melinda Henry, of Jacksonville, showed both power and strength at the 2009 Florida Senior Games State Championships. On Saturday, December 6 she won a gold medal in the Equipped Deadlift of the Powerlifting competition with a lift of 176 pounds. She returned the following weekend to win a gold medal in the 100 meter dash with a time of 15.85 in the 50-54 age group. It was the fastest time of all women runners in the event.

Fastest men's times in the 100 meter dash

Brian Hankerson, Hollywood, 12.49 Bill Tharpe, Tallahassee, 13.42 Edward Lundy, Jacksonville, 13.47 Richard Allen, Lakeland, 13.53 After setting records on Saturday in the field events, Brian Hankerson made his presence known on the track winning three gold medals. He won the 100 meter dash with the overall fastest time of 12.49, the 200 meter dash, running 26.04 and the 400 meter dash with a time of 57.96

The oldest competitor in the track and field competition, 95-year old James Kales, of Bonita Springs, established three new records in the 95-99 age group and set two new records. This was all on the heels of winning gold medals in bowling and tennis.


