This information supplements the USGA Local Rules and Terms of the Competition, Championship Pace of Play Policy, and the Code of Conduct Policy. Disregard any Local Rules found on the club scorecard or posted at the club.

FORMAT: 18 Holes of Stroke Play competition - Qualifier for National Senior Games

TEE MARKERS: Men = (50-59- White): (60-74 - Gold): (70-89- Silver): (90+ 9 Holes- Red) Women = (50-59 - Silver): (60-89-Red): (90+ 9 Holes- Red)

PACE OF PLAY: Pace of Play for this event is **4 Hours + 30 Minutes**. The FSGA's Championship Pace of Play Policy is in effect.

PENALTY AREAS: All are RED (lateral). The bulks heads along Hole #18 are integral objects within the penalty areas. (No Relief)

Out of Bounds: Includes: (a) Practice Range - defined by inside edge at ground level of white stakes (or white line); (b) Holes 3, 4, 6, 11, 13, 17 – perimeter fences are boundary fences; (c) Holes 7, 9 – defined by inside curb-edge of road (right of fairway); (d) Hole #18 – defined by inside edge of cart path located behind putting green; and, (e) Ground beyond water's edge of Lateral Penalty Areas adjacent to private property or tied to white stakes is OB.

Local Rule E-5 is in effect (alternate to stroke and distance): For two (2) penalty stokes a player may take relief for a ball that is either lost or "out of bounds" (**if a provisional ball has not been played). Relief area extends from the estimated point where the original ball was either lost or went out of bounds to the fairway + 2 club lengths. Drop the ball "no closer to the Hole" within this area and add 2 strokes to your score.

Doubt as to procedure: If you are unable to determine how to proceed under the Rules you may play 2 balls without penalty under Rule 20.1c. Before making a stroke at either ball you should announce to another player in your group your intent to play 2 balls and which ball you would like to count if both balls are played in accordance with the 'Rules. You should complete the Hole with both balls. You MUST report the facts of the situation to the Committee before returning your Scorecard.

Ground Under Repair: **Holes #14 –** drainage area right of cart path. Areas circled with white paint. Free Relief – (Nearest point of relief no closer to the Hole + one club length)

Closest to the Flagstick: Women - #5: Men - #8 // Long Drive: Women #10; Men #14

Evacuation: Mandatory Evacuation = one long blast of the air horns. Rendezvous' point is the Grill Room within the Club House

Play - Off.: In the event of a Tie the USGA tie breaker method will be used.

Scoring: Scoring is in the dining area within the Clubhouse. Upon completion of play scorecards should be immediately returned to the scoring area.
