Notice to Players

This information supplements the USGA Rules and Terms of the Competition, Championship Pace of Play Policy, and the Code of Conduct Policy. Disregard any Local Rules found on the club scorecard or posted at the club.

FORMAT: 18 Holes of Stroke Play competition

**TEE MARKERS: Men = (50-59- White): (60-74 – Gold): (75-89- Silver): (90+ 9 Holes-Silver)
Women = Silver (90+ 9 Holes- Silver)**

PACE OF PLAY: Pace of Play for this event is **4 Hours + 30 Minutes**. The FSGA's Championship Pace of Play Policy is in effect.

PENALTY AREAS: All are RED (lateral). Where the edge of a body of water is not marked, the edge of that *penalty area* is defined by its natural boundaries (that is, where the ground slopes down to form the depression that can hold the water, or the area where impenetrable vegetation begins).

Out of Bounds: Defined by the course side points at ground level of white stakes, white lines, and curbing or edge of public roadways. In addition, out of bounds is defined the outside edge of cart path/curbing on the these holes: **#3,#4,#5 (up to drain, then tied to stakes) ,#7,#8,#14,#15,#16,#18.**
WHERE THE NON-GOLF COURSE EDGE OF A CART PATH DEFINES OUT OF BOUNDS, THE PATH ITSELF IS AN OBSTRUCTION.

Local Rule E-5 is in effect (alternate to stroke and distance): For two (2) penalty strokes a player may take relief for a ball that is either lost or "out of bounds" (**if a provisional ball has not been played). Relief area extends from the estimated point where the original ball was either lost or went out of bounds to the fairway + 2 club lengths. Drop the ball "no closer to the Hole" within this area and add 2 strokes to your score.

Abnormal Course Conditions: Areas enclosed by white circle (Nearest point of complete relief no closer to the Hole + one club length no closer to hole)

Closest to the Hole: Women – #4: Men - #17 Long Drive: Women #1; Men #11

Play - Off.: In the event of a Tie the USGA tie breaker method will be used.

Scoring: Upon completion of play **signed** scorecards should be immediately returned to the scoring area.
